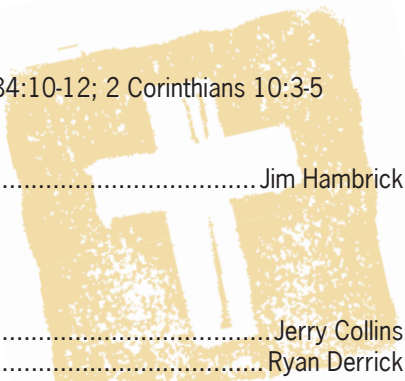

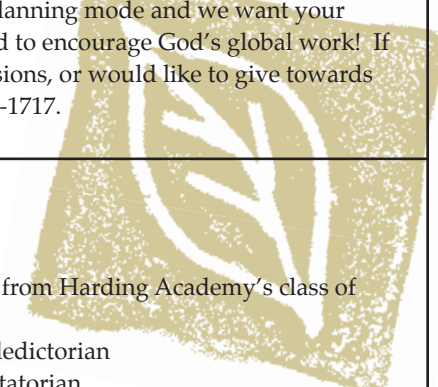

## Soma Summer 2012 Missions

This year the Christian Student Center is planning two mission trips. A group of six students will accompany Rusty Woods to Ishinomaki, Japan, one of the hardest hit places by the March 2011 tsunami. We will be helping renovate homes damaged by the tsunami. Many Japanese still live in the second floor while they wait for aid to repair their unlivable first floor. We will host cookouts in the parks to facilitate community building between the displaced, lonely Japanese people and the fledgling church. We will also share our testimonies of how God has transformed our lives and what He has done to renew people throughout history.

A group of ten students will accompany me to the Safe Home Children's Village in Liberia. While there, we will do a Vacation Bible School for village children in the mornings and then have a VBS for the Safe Home Children in the evenings. We hope to provide additional training for area ministers, and help out with ongoing farming efforts around the village. These trips are in full planning mode and we want your prayers and support as we travel around the world to encourage God's global work!
