If you were able to attend, you may remember the excitement. The bands playing outside, the cars from decades past, the Grizzlies player, the tours that were given to members of our community, the list could go on. It was a "perfect day."

We as a body dared to dream and imagine how God would use the Community Life Center. We gave of our money to see this dream become a reality. I want to challenge you now to give of your time and energy so you can see how God is blessing our dream. After all, you wouldn't buy a dream car and never drive it!
