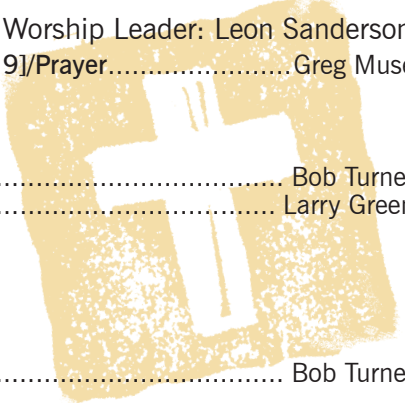

Volunteers Needed

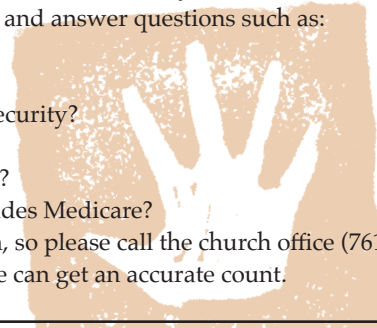

Senior Sunday

This morning, we are honoring our high school seniors in the Fellowship Hall service. Several of these students have grown up at White Station and several are newer additions to our family. When you see one of these soon-to-be graduates, please congratulate them on their accomplishment.

As a youth minister, there are a few things that I want to be sure our students know before they leave the youth group. First, I want them to know that they are loved by us and by God. We all go through periods when it's tough to feel the love that the Lord promises us as well as the love our community has for us. However, I hope that we all, especially our students, are able to recognize the constant presence of this love whether or not it's felt in the moment.

I also want students to know that they always have a place at White Station. Going into a new environment can be scary. Knowing that you have a home and a place that you will always belong is so important during transition. I hope every person who steps foot into our church family feels a sense of belonging, even if they go somewhere else.

Lastly, I want students to know specific people who care about them. According to the book *Sticky Faith* by Kara Powell and Chap Clark, studies show that students who have at least 5 caring adults in their lives by the time they leave the youth group are much more likely to stay in faith communities in the future. This is one of the many reasons why we have been doing our mentor program with graduating seniors for the past 10+ years. It's important for students to know the names of people who care about them. The mentors that are named in the Senior Service today are so valuable. However, that leaves 4+ open spots in each student's life. As you look for ways to invest in the various ministries at White Station, I urge you to contemplate how you might become a caring adult for one of our students. Let's work together as a family as we disciple our young people.

Please keep our 12 seniors in your prayers as they make a big transition over the next few months.
