Holiday Food Drive Starts Today!

You never know how our powerful God can work through us. A word of gratitude, a random act of kindness, saying I love you, saying I'm sorry, showing someone respect, praying with someone, or perhaps a hot shower, a place to stay the night, clean warm clothes, or providing a meal.

Did you know that White Station has a food pantry that distributes over 700 boxes of food a year? That's about 10 tons of food to hungry families in our community. In a recent press release from the Mid-South Food Bank, a study found that over 200,000 people in Shelby County – including 50,000 children – do not always know where they will find their next meal. In all, 22% of the population in Shelby County struggle with food insecurity.

Today begins our Holiday Food Drive. Empty boxes with food lists are located in the lobbies of our worship venues. Please consider participating in feeding the need in Memphis by filling as many boxes as possible with items on the food lists that will be provided on every empty box. Return your filled boxes to the lobby of any worship venue or the CLC by **Sunday, November 17th**. A prayer card is also attached. Sometimes prayer is what people desire most. Your written prayer of hope and encouragement will be a meaningful way to bless those who receive your box of food.

A special thank you goes to **Karen and Sonny Hubbard** for their tireless work leading White Station's food pantry ministry. May God bless those we serve through the Holiday Food Drive. We thank you for your prayers, your kind generosity and the food items donated to feed hungry families in our city.
