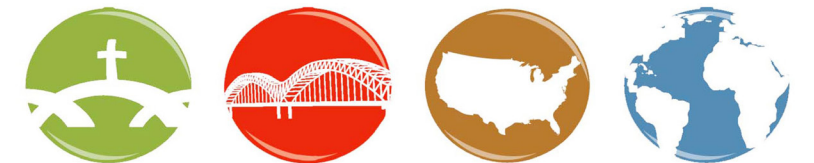

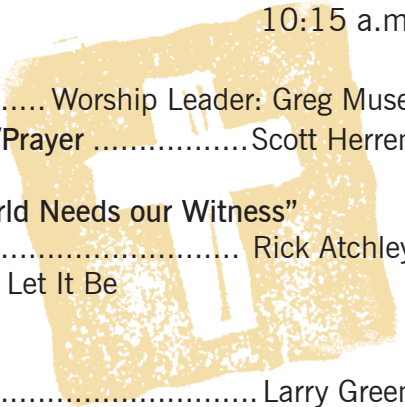

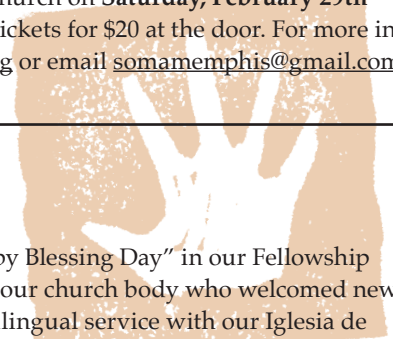
Men's Retreat

FOR THE WHITE STATION YOUTH GROUP

This summer, our teenagers are traveling to Ghana and Rhode Island to be a part of the Kingdom work in those areas. Your generosity next Sunday will help make it possible for our students to have experiences and serve people whom they would not otherwise meet or know. The funds allocated to youth missions will help lower the cost of our mission trips for students and adult leaders. Without your help, many would not be able to afford the cost of the trip. FOR GLOBAL MISSIONS

Ralph and Twyla Williams are answering the call to evangelism among the Maasai of Northern Tanzania. They share the gospel of Christ by living and teaching in a Maasai community. Twyla walks 4-5 miles (one way) several times a week to hold classes for women in the greater community where they live. Global Missions is asking that you participate in the special contribution next week with open hearts to help the Williams purchase an ATV (all terrain vehicle) for Twyla.

FOR MEDICAL MISSIONS

Our Medical Missions Team traveled to Ghana last month and they are already making plans for their next trip. The special contribution will be used to support the next medical mission trip in many ways. Funds will be used to provide tents, awnings, water and translators in the 5 villages where Frank Hotorwoshie, our missionary in Ghana, preaches. Funds will also provide medicines for treating patients in the 5 villages where the Medical Mission Team will serve. There are plans to expand the pharmacy formulary to options and newer treatments such as antibiotics, antihypertensives and eye treatments. The number of patients needing treatment grows every year and our hope is that funding provided on Missions Sunday will allow for treatment to all that need medical attention while the Medical Missions Team is in Ghana.

FOR CITY MISSIONS

White Station is blessed to have Iglesia de Cristo as part of our church family. As City Missions desires to have more bilingual worship opportunities and bilingual events, they would like to use funding from Missions Sunday to purchase additional headphones that will make it easier for translators to interpret during joint events. These headphones will allow Spanish speakers to take part in more events at White Station as well as allow Iglesia services to be translated for English speaking visitors. Additional funding would provide start up costs for a "Conversational Coffee House," which is an initiative that will create opportunities to bridge language barriers and deepen relationships between our Spanish speaking and English speaking members.
